

Making the Pot

1. Print off the pattern sheet on card and then carefully cut out the patterns using the dotted lines.
2. Bring both edges of the circular flower pot together. Making sure the tab is on the inside, use glue or sticky tape to secure the edges together.
3. Do the same for the thinner outer rim of the flower pot as described in step 2.
4. Make sure you have cut the dotted lines to the centre of the white flower pot shapes, then slot them together and fold the tabs over.
5. With these two shapes slotted together, fit the crossed support shape into the flower pot created in step 2. Make sure the tabs you cut slot onto the flower pot.
6. Attach the tabs of the support piece to the inside of the flower pot outer rim created in step 3, aligning the tabs with the bottom of the rim.
7. Use a pencil or pen to push a hole through the centre of the brown circle and then place the circle inside the flower pot.

Making the Flower

1. Using a straw as the stem of the flower, stick the straw to the back of one of the flowers with some sticky tape.
2. With a rolled up piece of sticky tape or glue, secure the back of the 2nd flower to the back of the first flower, so the straw is sandwiched between the flowers and the flower then has colour on both sides.
3. Cut the straw to the length required and then place a small slit, upwards into the bottom of the straw.
4. Attach the leaf/leaves by wrapping it around the straw with the coloured side facing outward. Stick the leaf together with glue or sticky tape.
5. Place the flower inside the pot and secure it by slotting the small cut in the straw onto the support piece inside the pot.
